We have a new and exciting partnership with the Greater Lansing Food Bank this school year to provide access to Weekend Food Kits to any family in need within our district.

There are no eligibility requirements and no cost to participate in this program.

This program is supplemental to the free breakfast and lunch programs offered at schools every day and is intended to meet the nutritional needs of children during non-school hours, specifically over the weekend or longer breaks. Each Weekend Kit includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snack items. Foods included are kid-friendly items that are easy for your children to prepare or help prepare. Weekend Kits are designed to slip discreetly into your child's backpack and are distributed to participating children every other week.

Attached to this letter is a <u>Participation Form</u> that can be completed and returned to Ms. Ebenhoeh at the Elementary School or Ms. Kviz at the Jr./Sr. High School to enroll your family.

The names of participants are kept confidential and are only shared between the school social workers and food service staff.
