Caps & Gowns:

Early College Students:

Important SENDOB Information

Thursday, May 9th: INTERFAITH BACCALAUREATE SERVICE

Held in the high school auditorium at 6:00 p.m. Students should wear graduation gowns. This is an optional event.

Thursday, May 9th: SENIOR HONORS NIGHT

Held in the high school gym at 7:00 p.m. Students will be invited if they have earned honors to be announced this evening, however all seniors are welcome to attend to support and cheer on their classmates! Students should wear graduation gowns.


