



Let's Warm Up the Winter!

This holiday season, the Junior High students will have the opportunity to give to a local organization, The Old News Boys, and spread some warmth. The donations will be accepted through Dec. 18th. As an incentive, students will receive tickets for their donations and will be entered into a drawing for one of several gift bags. To the Parent(s) or Guardian(s) of New Lothrop Area Transported Students:

Please allow us a moment of your time to tell you about the contents of this envelope.

New Lothrop Area Public Schools was fortunate enough to qualify for a Safety and Security Grant this past school year. Along with that qualification we were able to do a few things for our Transportation Department and the Buses.

We were able to purchase the item in this envelope for each stop deemed necessary, which is an item meant to be used as a <u>Personal Safety Device</u> while at the Bus Stop. Please take a moment and read the enclosed note about this device.

Please Note:

If you did not get the additional information sheet and a LED device inside of the envelope it was initially determined that because the bus is met by you and your student(s) at the stop in a vehicle or the structure lighting behind them provides enough light of the safety for your student(s) possibly at a group stop.

We are passing along the balance of this letter for your information about what's changing and or has changed with NL Transportation.

Video Safety and Security:

We were able to install Video Systems on all of our buses which will allow us to monitor what is going on inside and out of the buses.

This is both a Safety and Security feature for everyone on board, for event recall and for forensic evidence when needed to confirm any incident.

This video will only be used when necessary and shared with <u>No One</u> outside of the Administration of New Lothrop Area Public Schools.

Video Operation:

One of the more important parts of these video systems is that it gives the driver the ability to postmark an event of concern for later review, including events on the bus or a traffic event. Such as a **Red Light Violation** in which a vehicle runs the Red Flashing Lights while the bus is stopped at a student pick-up or drop-off location. As some of you may or may not be aware of, this has become a national safety concern, and now there are laws in place that will aid NL Transportation to work more closely with law enforcement agencies to put a stop to drivers ignoring our Stopped Buses when our **Red Lights** and **Stop Signs** are deployed. Each bus is equipped with two high resolution cameras mounted to the exterior, one facing forward and the other facing backward. These cameras are mounted in such a way that they will capture the image of a driver, the vehicle, and most importantly a picture of the license plate which will enable law enforcement to tag someone for the illegal passing of a school bus while stopped.

New Buses & Safety Equipment:

Along with acquiring New Bus leases which came with some new Safety Devices mounted on the exterior of the buses. We were fortunate enough to acquire the same safety equipment for the exterior of our existing leased buses. These devices include back lighted **School Bus** signage on the top front and rear of the buses. These signs make the buses very visible on a dark morning or night while on the road. Secondly we were able to replace the **Stop Arms & Signs** on our existing buses to match exactly like the new units, with back lighted Stop Signs while deployed these signs are now visible from more than 300 feet away.

On a More Personal Note and Plea for Support:

We would also like to make an announcement and an appeal to you as parents and guardians of our New Lothrop Transported Students. Yes we have added new buses to our fleet with the new lease of these buses comes an opportunity to make some changes on what is and is not allowed on the buses. Since we hope to keep these buses for 6 years and would like to take care of them inside as much as outside. We are asking for your help in maintaining the interior of buses and helping the drivers to do that. We have had these rules for a number of years but were seldom fully enforced. There will be "No more Eating of any type of Food on the Buses" that includes **GUM** and Drinking of any juice drinks, or any beverage with sugar in it.) We will allow Water Only in bottles that have resealable lids/tops and ask that when the students are not drinking from their bottle that they keep it tightly closed, and or even in their backpack. Although water does dry up it leaves behind moisture that causes a mess that the drivers are not equipped to deal with, and gets into cracks and crevices that are not easy to clean / dry up. As for any food it only leads to more issues of cleanliness with crumbs and waste being shoved down in between the seat cushions and the wall of the bus. This becomes a breeding ground for any number of problems of allergies, or other health related issues to include rodents, ants etc. So please encourage your students to Refrain from eating anything on the bus. During the daily route when most of the eating is taking place, the students who have snack packs in their backpacks and decide that they are "too hungry" to wait and need to eat them while on the ride home will no longer be condoned.

Special Occasions:

Most if not all bus rides are under or very close to an hour in length, they can wait until they get home. If time needs to be made to stop for a meal during a trip because it exceeds an hour or more then that is something we can address on a as needed basis. In fact there is a section on the Transportation Request form asking if the requester needs or wants to make a "Food Stop" either Yes or No checkboxes are there on the form.

Working Time After Fully Charged:

- 5-8 Hrs in high-bright
- 13-15 Hrs in medium bright
- 17-20 Hrs in Red light flashing
- Press the power button on the end of the unit to change the status or color of the LEDs.
